

Dear Guest:

Thank you for staying with Beyond Pesticides. We hope you enjoy your visit to Washington, DC. The Beyond Pesticides office is located at 7th and E Streets Southeast in the Capitol Hill neighborhood and is just a short walk to public transportation (one block North on 7th St. at Pennsylvania Ave), great restaurants (along Penn Ave. and 8th St.) and historic Eastern Market (one block North past the metro on Pennsylvania Ave.). The bedroom, with its own private bath, is located on the third floor. Towels and bed linens are kept in the closet in your room, and toiletries are in the bathroom.

- Alarm System Please enter and exit by the front door. The back door in your room is a
 fire escape only. When you leave the office, please set the alarm by pressing 3 (Away) +
 1234. When you return, disable the alarm by pressing 1 (Off) + 1234. The front door,
 backdoor (fire escape) and the windows in the bedroom must be closed to set the
 alarm.
- Kitchen Please feel free to use the kitchen during your stay. Eastern Market, DC's historic farmer's market, and Yes! Organic Market are just a few blocks away (walk East on E St. to 8th St SE., turn left for Yes! or walk North two blocks on 7th St SE to Eastern Market). Please clean up after you are finished. Dish soap and detergent are kept under the sink.
- Internet Access The wireless network name is ncamp and the password is termite1.
- **Television** <u>To change the channel, please use the VCR or remote control</u>, keep the TV channel set as it is. Beyond Pesticides has a library of videos.
- **Phone** There is a phone located in your room. You can dial locally or use your personal calling card for long distance calls.
- **Emergencies** Should you need to urgently reach someone from Beyond Pesticides, please call Jay Feldman's cell at (202) 255-4296.
- Office Hours Beyond Pesticides office hours are 9:00am–5:00pm, Monday-Friday. Staff usually arrive just before 9:00 and leave by 6:00. During these hours, you are welcome to be on the third floor, but please be discreet.
- **Restaurants** There are many dining options in this neighborhood. We recommend walking one block to 8th Street. There are many good restaurants on 8th Street SE between D and H Streets.
